Return to the vessel for a hearty buffet lunch, before helping to raise the sails and sail back to shore across the Whitsunday Passage, with a cold beer or wine in hand, from our licensed bar. During your day sail learn about the reef and islands from our passionate Eco Accredited guides, get involved and help sail a tall ship for a once in a lifetime experience, or sit back and relax the choice is yours!
